The Director of Programs is responsible for the operational success of Empower House programs: Community Health, Empower Youth, and Radio – ensuring seamless team management and professional development, program delivery, data management, continuous quality improvement and evaluation. The Director of Programs will directly supervise three Program Managers and the Data Analyst.

Team Management and Development:

- Support managers and strategize with them to achieve quarterly and annual goals and priorities
- Collaborate with managers to establish clear expectations for staff and programs rooted in job descriptions and program goals.
- Maintain clear expectations and mutual accountability among team members by modeling consistent oversight of individual and organization standards rooted in EHSA's mission, vision, and values.
